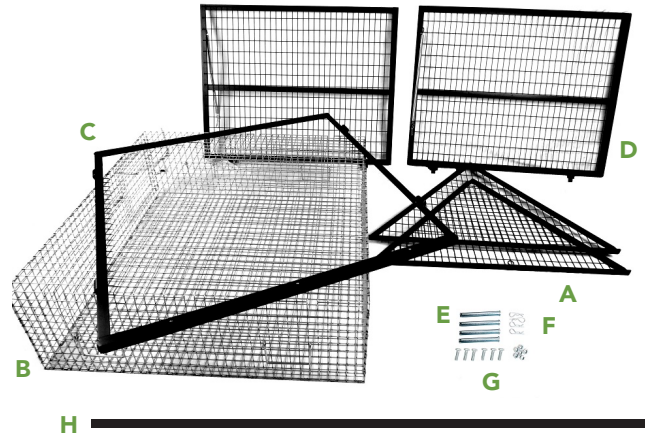

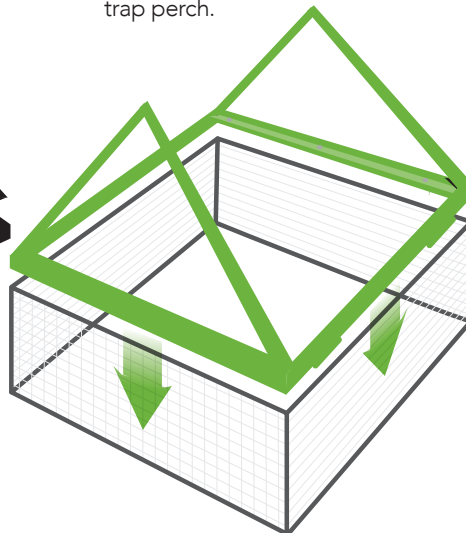
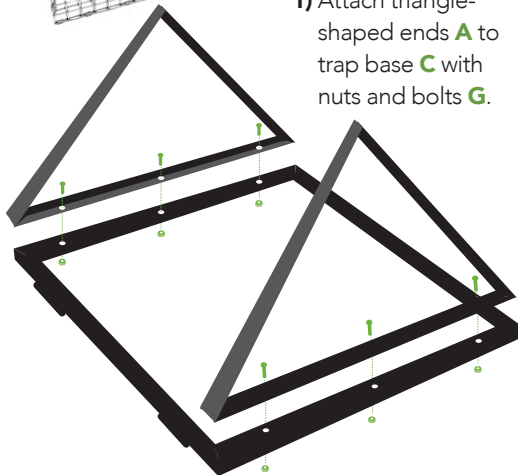
We must receive proof of a FEDERAL MIGRATORY BIRD DEPREDAATION PERMIT before we can ship this trap. This trap works by placing bait in the lower section of the trap and setting the perch to hold open the trap doors. When a bird of prey lands on the perch to investigate, the perch gives way under the weight of the bird causing the trap doors to close above it. When deployed the trap measure 36L x 36W x 42H. To reduce shipping costs and avoid damage during shipping, the Bird of Prey Trap is delivered un-assembled. An instructional assembly video is available on our instructions page.

Parts List

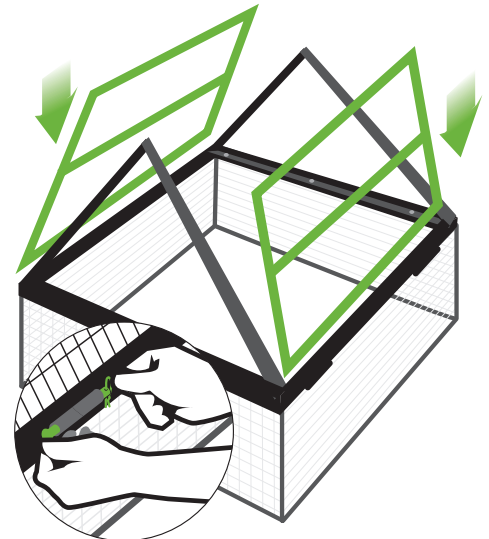
- A. 2 – triangle-shaped end panels,
- B. 1 – bait cage,
- C. 1 – trap base,
- D. 2 – trap wings,
- E. 4 – lattice pins,
- F. 4 – cotter pins,
- G. 6 – nuts, 6 – bolts.
- H. 1 – Completely assembled trap perch.



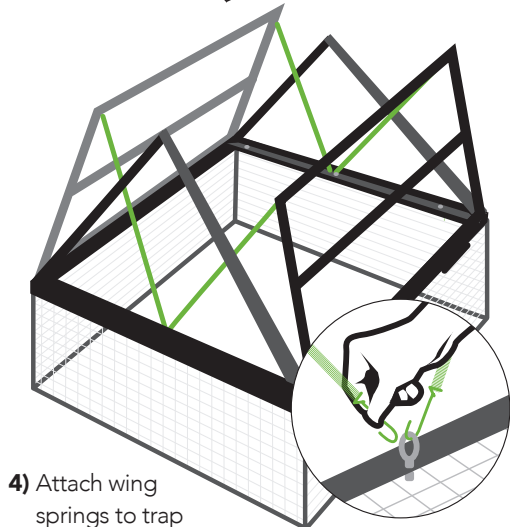
- 1) Attach triangle-shaped ends **A** to trap base **C** with nuts and bolts **G**.



- 2) Place assembled trap base with attached ends on bait cage **B**. Base frame should fit perfectly over bait cage.

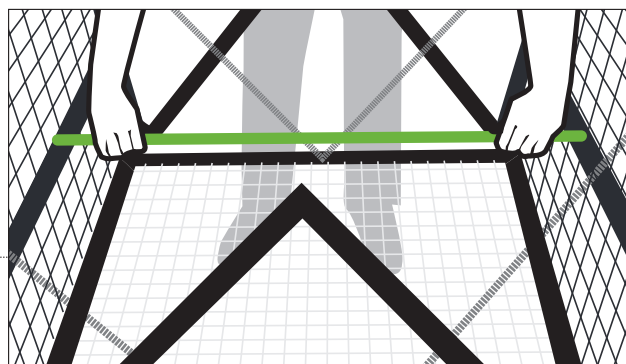


- 3) Install trap wings **D** on trap base with lattice pins **E** and secure with cotter pins **F**.



- 4) Attach wing springs to trap base. Trap is now assembled.

Setting Your Trap



1. Pull trap wings back and put perch **H** in place to hold wings open. Perch should rest on the middle angle iron support of each wing near the center. Trap is now deployed.
- 2) Place bait in bait cage.
