Freeman Hammock Net Instructions

The Hammock Net is an excellent field net featuring a flexible hoop that allows the net head to bend against hard surfaces making it easier to capture with less chance of escape. These nets feature tough yet stretchable nylon netting. Small mesh gives more comfort and reduces animal injuries. A quick cord closure with nylon cordlock secures the animal safely within the netting. This net can accommodate animals up to 45lbs. Net hoop diameter is approximately 17" and net bag is approximately 40" deep.

FP-CH Classic Hammock Net - This net is not telescopic and does not extend. It measures 62" from end to end with a 40" handle.

FP-24H Extension Hammock Net - This net is telescopic and measures 47" when collapsed and 69" when extended.

FP-36H Extension Hammock Net Long - This net is telescopic and measures 59" when collapsed and 92" when extended.

Please note that some assembly is required on this product, you can view the video for assembly instructions or download an information sheet on the Freeman Hammock Net.

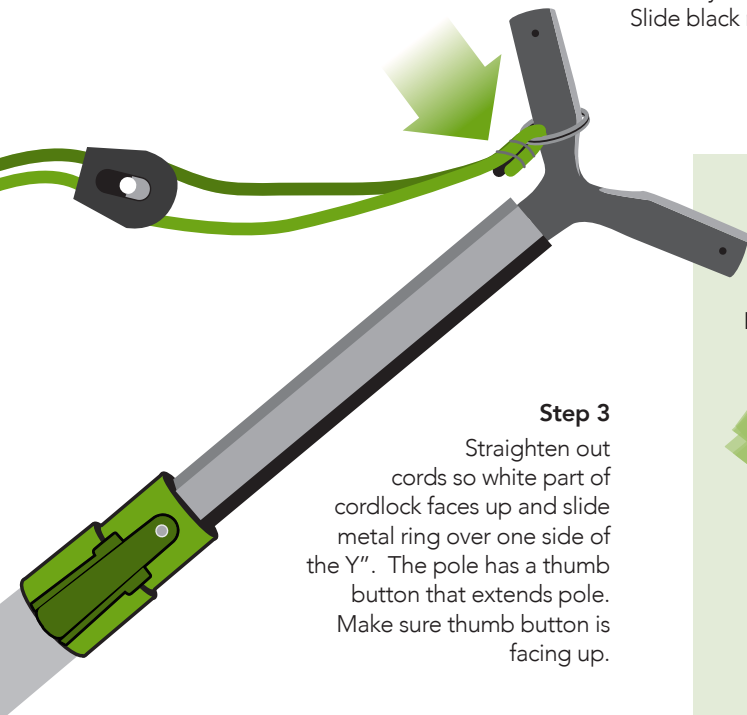


Step 1

Pull orange cap off side of "Y" to find four screws, a screw driver bit and drill bit.

Step 2

Carefully feed flexible rod through black meshing until entire rod is evenly situated. Slide black netting over rod. It will not work if you push the rod through.



Step 3

Straighten out cords so white part of cordlock faces up and slide metal ring over one side of the "Y". The pole has a thumb button that extends pole. Make sure thumb button is facing up.

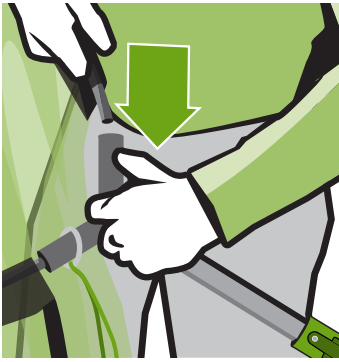

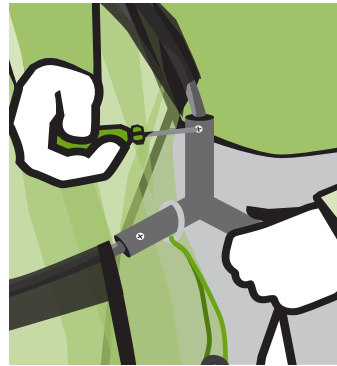

Step 4

With blue seam inside net bag, cordlock facing up, and cords straight (not crossed) push one rod end fully into one side of the "Y". When done, insert other end of rod into other side of the "Y". Make sure black nylon net web slides freely over metal "Y" and nylon hoop.



Step 5

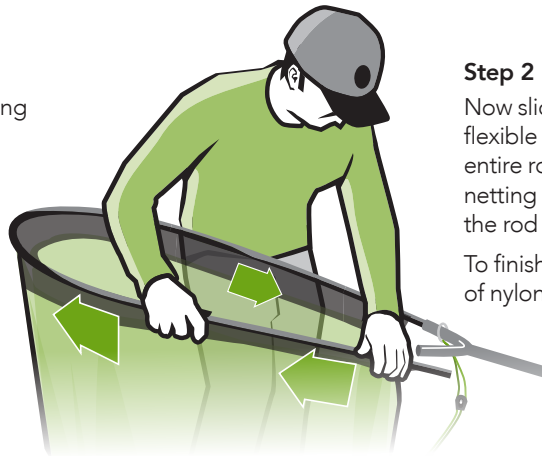
Once both ends of rod are fully within "Y", drill very shallow pilot holes in nylon rod, through existing holes in the metal with the 3/32" bit provided. Drill only 1/3 of the way through the plastic rod. Install screws in these holes using the screw driver bit provided.

REPLACING THE HAMMOCK NET:



Step 1

Unscrew non-ring side rod at "Y" and pulloff old net.



Step 2

Now slide on new net. Carefully feed flexible rod through black meshing until entire rod is evenly situated. Slide black netting over rod, it will not work if you push the rod through.

To finish, install new screws in existing holes of nylon rod.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

To operate the extension pole, Push on the thumb button located on the collar to release the pole and allow it to extend. Select the appropriate length by releasing the thumb button into the appropriate hole of the inner tube.

To secure animal inside net, hold cords & push cordlock toward net until tight. The cordlock will self lock. To release the cordlock, put your thumb on the plastic wheel and pull the wheel & cordlock back at the same time.

Lift and carry an animal only by gripping cords of the net bag in your gloved hand. The pole/handle is used only for directing the netting over an animal. *Carrying an animal by the pole or any other way other than the cords may damage the mechanisms.*

CARE:

- Be gentle please- avoid putting pressure on the extended handle and mechanisms.
- Lift the netted animal with the 2 cords. Do not use the handle or the hoop to lift.
- The hoop and handle are only to contain the animal with the netting, do not to carry the animal by the hoop or handle.
- Yes you can spray down this unit all you like. It is made of no rust aluminum and stainless steel. The netting is 100% nylon & will not rot.
- Caution: Do not use bleach or any solution containing sodium hypochlorite since it will damage the netting and mechanisms. Use fabric softener in a dip bucket if the netting stiffens from cleaners.
- Do not store in direct sunlight.
